"Dinners in the Field" 2015: The third annual "Dinners in the Field" series from Field & Vine and chef Pascal Chureau expands to **20 dinners** in 2015 and grows to include Stoller Vineyards, Dobbes Family Estate, Gompers Gin, Deschutes Brewery, Owen Roe Cellars, Portland Creamery and new venues, including the Rosse Posse Elk Farm and the Long Farm Barn, Daniel Boone's 150-year-old family farm in West Linn. Field & Vine will also partner with **Farmers Ending Hunger** for one dinner on July 25, with a portion of the proceeds donated to the non-profit organization. Dinner guests will enjoy a **six- to seven-course dinner** paired with wine, beer or spirits from nearby wineries, breweries and distilleries, and a tour of the space.
